



2023 Tractor Pull Rules, Regulations and Prize Pool

1. The use of alcohol beverages and/or drugs is not allowed in the pit area at any time.
2. **Contest is to be governed by judges with all judges decisions final.** Judges have the right to stop and disqualify participants at any time. Entry fee will not be refunded.
3. All under age drivers must have a parent's written permission. Parents assume all responsibility, subject to judges' decisions.
4. No full cut tires.
5. **Un-sportsman like conduct will not be tolerated. It will result in a year and one day suspension.**
6. You can only protest another tractor and driver in your class.
7. No part of the tractor may interfere with the sled during the pull.
8. Operator must remain seated during entire pull and have complete control of the tractor at all times.
9. Tractor may downshift during the pull provided the forward motion of the sled is continued. The use of torques, amplifiers, and power shifts is permitted.
10. Tractor and skid must both remain within the boundaries of the course.
11. If any parts or equipment fall off the tractor, tractor will be disqualified.
12. All engine fans must be factory or shrouded steel 1/16" or thicker. All turbos not under a hood must be completely shrouded except for inlet and exhaust pipe 1/16" or thicker.
13. Front weights and support frame must be a maximum 11" from center of rear axle. Weights must be safely secured and must not be on three-point arms.
14. Only one type of fuel per tractor.
15. All ignition engines must have a kill switch within reach of driver.
16. All exhausts must be factory or discharged vertically above highest point of tractor, no rain caps or curved exhaust pipes on hobby or open classes.
17. All classes will use standard drawbar rules. Minimum drawbar length of 18" from the center of the rear wheel to the point of hook measured horizontally. Drawbar must be stationary in all directions. There is a maximum height of 20" from the hitching points parallel to the ground. Pull point may not be more than 1-1/2" from the back edge of hitching device. No bracing drawbar to 3-point or top link.
18. All tractors must have working rear brakes.
19. **Dual tires are allowed in 16,500 farm stock only** and must meet proper size requirements. They must be securely fastened with a minimum of 6 bolts.
20. All weight classes are with driver and allowed no extra weight.
21. Farm & Improved Farm Stock classes must have working PTO unless not equipped from factory. Tractors must have stock hood, seat assembly, fuel tank, rear fenders, floor plates, etc.
22. Contesting of a tractor will be \$100 paid up front per tractor.



2019 Tractor Pull Rules, Regulations and Prize Pool

Farm Stock

3750, 4500, 5500, 7000, 9000

Speed Limits

3750 and 5000: 6 mph

Tire Size

3750 and 5000: max size 16.9-38

7000 and 9000: 18.4-38

Farm stock natural wear only, nothing else allowed.

Farm Improved Stock

10500 Turbo, 12000, and 16500

Factory appearing or stock replacement block, carburetor, injection pump, front end, and drive train for that make and model. Allis WC & WD can run D17 block.

All tractors must have fenders and floor plate.

*10000 factory turbo, Max 2.1 turbo at intake or factory add-on turbos (such as 4020 or 966 with turbo).

*10000 Turbo Tractor must have a factory wide front.

12000 and up factory replacement turbo, exhaust and intake must hook-up with no modification.

10000 and up 3000 RMP limit.

No block spacers. Governor requirement. Factory RPM set up pump for that make and model.

Tire Size

10000 Turbo: 18.4-38

12000 and 16500: no limit

10000 Hobby

Roll over protection and dead man throttle required. Wide front minimum of 60 inches, 3x4 turbo allowed. Scatter blankets and wheelie bars required. Must have breakaway switch and second emergency shutoff within reach of driver. Cut tires, power blocks allowed. Only one fuel (gas, propane, diesel fuel/no nitrous or oxidizers). Quick release side panels removable for inspection. Fuel shutoff between pump and fuel filters.

Open and Modified

6200, and 7500

Must have safety blanket on clutch and flywheel. Wheelie bars required. Must have breakaway switch and second emergency shutoff within reach of driver. Factory appearing block. Exhaust pipe must be cross bolted. Front dampener covered. Helmet and fire suit are MANDATORY. Sturdy roll over protection required. Wide front must track within rear wheels.

Any driver or pit man under the influence of either drugs or alcohol will disqualify that tractor and driver and will be escorted from the pit area by the Isanti County Sheriff. Drivers are reminded they are responsible for the conduct of their pit crew.

Indemnification Clause:

Participant shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless the Isanti County Fair, Isanti County Agricultural Society, County of Isanti, and Cambridge Township, including their respective Officers, Council Members, Commissioner, Agents and Employees from any and all liability, claims, demands, expenses, fees, fines, penalties, suits proceedings and causes of any action of any and every kind and nature arising out of or in any way connected with the participation in the Isanti County Fair Tractor Pull on Friday, July 26th, 2019.
