## **FAIRGROUND RULES**

### **ISANTI COUNTY AGRICULTURAL SOCIETY RULES GOVERNING THE MANAGEMENT AND CONTROL OF THE ISANTI COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS AND ISANTI COUNTY FAIR**

1. Fair hours and Admissions: Fair hours are 8am to 12 midnight. Fair officially opens at 3pm on Wednesday. No one will be admitted to the fairgrounds without a pass or paid admission. Buildings will be open from 10am to 10pm daily. Admission prices are set by the board of directors and reviewed annually.

2. No concealed weapons allowed on grounds. The Isanti County Fair bans handguns on the premises.

3. No roller skates, in-line skates, skate boards, bicycles, or other wheeled vehicles are allowed on fairgrounds.

4. No dogs allowed on fairgrounds except Certified Service Animals for individuals with disabilities. No cats, reptiles, snakes, aquatic creatures or any other exotic animals.

5. No person shall be permitted to distribute advertising matter on the grounds, except from their place of business or exhibit, unless a concession fee is paid at the office. The tacking or posting of advertisements or distribution of bills, cards, flyers, stickers, etc. is prohibited. Anyone violating this rule will be liable to a fine and expulsion from the grounds as the Board of Directors may elect.

6. No person or group of persons shall banner, picket, march, protest, demonstrate or caucus on the Isanti County Fairgrounds before or during the fair in any manner that interferes with the convenience or safety of any county fair patron, exhibitor or employee. Anyone doing so will be made to leave the main fairgrounds and stage in space designated by the Board of Directors outside of fenced perimeter.

7. Any interference by exhibitors, competitors, or fair visitors, to influence or dictate the judge or officials in any competitive exhibit, contest, or event will be sufficient reason to disqualify the person competing. Any interference of this nature should be reported to the superintendent, coordinator of such event or to the fair secretary.

8. Absolutely no alcohol will be permitted to be brought on the grounds. No drugs or drug use will be permitted on the grounds. Anyone violating this rule will be escorted from the fairgrounds by the Isanti County Sheriff.

9. There will be no personal vehicles or support vehicles allowed inside the grounds for any reason during fair hours without fair board approval. No vehicles on grounds during the fair until Sunday at 6pm. Any unauthorized vehicles parked inside will be towed at owner's expense.
