## AUTO ~ 5 Lap Max

4 Cylinders	1 <sup>st</sup> \$200 and Trophy	2 <sup>nd</sup> \$100	3 <sup>rd</sup> \$50
6 Cylinders	1 <sup>st</sup> \$200 and Trophy	2 <sup>nd</sup> \$100	3 <sup>rd</sup> \$50
8 Cylinders (Trucks & SUVs)	1 <sup>st</sup> \$200 and Trophy	2 <sup>nd</sup> \$100	3 <sup>rd</sup> \$50

1. A minimum of 6 cars for each class will apply.
2. Each class will be set up in its own bracket, however; the Isanti County Fair reserves the right to add, combine, or eliminate a class depending on the number of entries received.

## POWDER PUFF ~ 5 Lap Max

1<sup>st</sup> \$250 and Trophy      2<sup>nd</sup> \$100      3<sup>rd</sup> \$50

1. Classes will be determined on the night of the event
  - a. 4 or 6-cylinder cars **ONLY**
2. Each class will be set up in their own bracket, however; the Isanti County Fair reserves the right to add, combine, or eliminate a class depending on the number of entries received.

## APPLIANCE RACE ~ 3 laps or more

1st Place - Trophy & \$150    2nd Place - \$100    3rd Place - \$75

1. Standard Passenger vehicle- Any sedan or hardtop automobile
  - a. No trucks or convertibles
2. **All glass**, plastic, metal trim, and anything that may fall off must be removed prior to entering the fairgrounds.
  - a. Any vehicle **spilling glass** will be immediately disqualified. Windshield is optional - if it gets broken, you may be subject to disqualification. You must use screening if the windshield is removed.
3. **3 person teams**
  - a. One driver and two pit crew members (pit crew must also have appropriate gear as if racing) Driver will stay in vehicle entire race.
  - b. Pit crew must ride the lap with the driver inside the vehicle in a seat, with a seatbelt and helmet, gloves. Pit crew will exit out of the rear driver-side door.
  - c. **If any team member is hanging out of the vehicle, the team is subject to disqualification!**
4. No intentional hitting vehicles of other team(s)
5. You may use any kind of strap that will fit to hold an appliance on your car
6. Will be based on the fastest time for the final feature
7. All appliances need to be strapped on the exterior of the vehicle for this race.

**HIGH 5 BACKWARDS RACE ~ 5 Lap Max**

**1<sup>st</sup> \$200 and Trophy**

**2<sup>nd</sup> \$100**

**3<sup>rd</sup> \$75**

1. Classes will be determined on the night of the event
  - a. 4 or 6-cylinder cars **ONLY**
2. Each class will be set up in its own bracket, but the Isanti County Fair reserves the right to add, combine, or eliminate a class based on the number of entries.

**TRAILER RACES ~ Run until last trailer is attached**

**1<sup>st</sup> \$600 and Trophy**

**2<sup>nd</sup> \$400**

**3<sup>rd</sup> \$200**

1. Any kind of vehicle with a trailer attached on ball hitch
  - a. Tongue must be attached to the tow vehicle by hitch and ball, free pivoting and removable for inspection. **NO WELDING**
  - b. Travel Trailer/pop-up camper, boat on a trailer, snowmobile trailer or utility trailer is eligible
2. Travel trailers/campers must be **completely cleaned out**
  - a. All appliances and heating/cooling units must be removed
  - b. **All glass must be removed**
  - c. Remove everything that is not part of the unit (i.e., pots/pans, clothes, silverware, trash, household items or anything that is not a permanent part of the trailer as manufactured.
  - d. Pop-ups must be raced in fully extended/popped-up position
3. Boats must be strapped to the trailer and **must be gutted**
  - a. No motors
  - b. No fuel tanks
  - c. No outdrives
4. The trailers must be between 8' to 22' in length
  - a. **No Implement or heavy equipment trailers**
  - b. Trailer cannot be rigged to self-destruct, leaving only the frame to continue racing, and must be able to race without falling apart
    - i. If the trailer is rigged, that driver will be disqualified
5. Safety chains and equalizer bars are not allowed
6. Ballast or weight cannot be added
7. Once your trailer is disconnected, you are disqualified
  - a. There will be **NO** safety chains allowed
8. Finish the race with your trailer attached while trying to separate the trailers of your competitors from their tow vehicles. If you lose your trailer, you will be disqualified, and you will be black-flagged
9. **NO** intentional hitting of tow vehicle: if you hit another tow vehicle intentionally with your vehicle, you will be immediately disqualified
