

NIGHT OF DESTRUCTION DRIVER RULES & REGULATIONS and VEHICLE

PREPARATION

1. All drivers and entrants to the pit area must be 16 years of age or older
 - a. Any drivers and or pitman under the age of 18 will be required to provide a notarized waiver signed by a parent or legal guardian
 - b. All pitmen will pay a \$20 Pit Fee. The driver admitted at N/C with paid entry
2. No 4-wheel drives unless the front driveshaft is removed
3. All drivers must have
 - a. Helmets ~ If using a face shield, recommended the use of goggles in addition to a neck brace (recommended) & gloves
 - b. **Factory Seat Belts**
 - c. Eye Protection ~ Immediate disqualification of not wearing while racing
 - d. Long pants are required, a long-sleeved shirt is recommended, and boots are required.
 - e. Recommended Fire extinguisher within reach of driver mounted securely.
4. Pit gates open at 12 pm ~ Please enter off of County Rd #2
5. Vehicle inspection closes **90 minutes** before the start of the race
6. You should be at the fairgrounds at least 3 hours before the event.
 - a. **Event Registration closes at 4:00 PM the night of the event.**
7. All cars must be ready to run before final inspection
8. A pit meeting will be held 60 minutes before the start of the event – **REQUIRED for all DRIVERS**
 9. Any vehicle **or** driver that is deemed unsafe at any time will be **disqualified**
 10. We ask that you help clean up your pit area, remove any parts or pieces, and load them in your car. Any vehicle not removed by 10:00 am on Sunday will become the property of the Isanti County Fair and be removed by FairBoard
11. **Absolutely NO Drugs or Alcohol Allowed in the PITS!**
 - a. Any driver or pitman observed using or under the influence of either, before or during the event will be disqualified, and that vehicle and driver with loss of any awards and or prize money will be escorted from the pit area by the IsantiCounty Sheriff's Department

VEHICLE PREPARATION

Number One Priority in these Events is the Safety of the Participants

All Races must follow vehicle prep rules.

1. All glass, plastic, metal trim, and **anything that may fall off** must be **removed** before entering the fairgrounds
 - a. Any vehicle **spilling glass** will be immediately disqualified
 - b. Windshield is optional - if it gets broken, you may be subject to disqualification
 - c. You **must** use screening if the windshield is removed
2. **Radiators must be stock automotive equipment in stock factory position with no bracing**
3. Sunroof openings must be sealed off with securely mounted steel or screening.
4. All vehicles must have working brakes
5. For your safety, please disable airbags
6. Bumpers can be chained, welded, or cabled to the frame
 - a. No angle, no channel, no additional bracing
7. Hoods & Doors need to be secured shut with chains or hood pins.
8. **Battery may be moved to the front or rear seat area and must be covered and mounted securely.**
9. Passenger tires only (stock)
 - a. No wider or greater than 60 series
 - i. Wheels must be of like size
 - ii. No studded tires or chains
 - iii. No wheel weights
10. Keep vehicles as stock as possible
 - Driver door is required to have factory inside door panel or like material
 - Driver door reinforcement, encouraged not needed, for driver safety
11. **Vehicle # must be on each side of the vehicle** (front door panels). Roof tags are highly encouraged
